CLEVER HACKS TO SAVE SPACE IN YOUR RV/CAMPER


These ten tips will make your camping home clutter-free

Summertime beckons, and the camping season is kicking into full gear. All over the beautiful Okanagan, people will get into RV's or campers to pursue that perfect nature holiday. And when you're on a long road trip or living in a reduced area, space is of the essence. The last thing you want is to feel cramped and uncomfortable or to have your rest crowded out by a cluttered living space. Here are 10 easy and inexpensive tips to make the most of the space inside your home away from home.

1) Use wall-mounted magnetic strips in the kitchen to hold knives and scissors

2) Get a desk lamp that has a power outlet in it. It will give you an extra reachable outlet and will save the need for bulky extension cords.

3) Make a storage headboard. A towel rack and hanging fabric with pockets sewn in can give you storage options that save the need for a bedside table.



5) A dish cradle keeps plates vertical, taking advantage of unused space and freeing up some in the counter/ cupboard.

6) Nesting bowls and measuring spoons allow you to put many items in one spot.

7) Hang a shelf or hanging basket above/beside your sink to add instant storage to your kitchen serving area.

8) Suction cup hooks can be put almost anywhere and can be used for everything from keys to utensils to oven mitts.

9) Use Velcro to keep your remotes or flashlights in place to avoid extra clutter.

10) Fasten brooms, mops, or other long items to the ceiling for convenient out-of-the-way storage.
